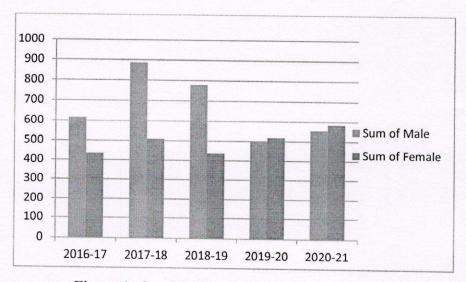
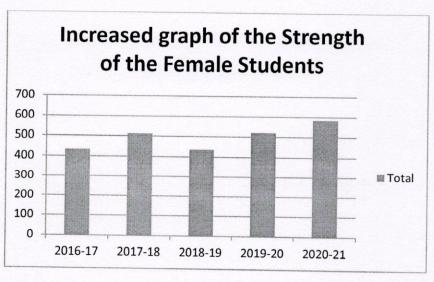


Figure 1: Gender Wise Students Strength
